

EMMA LONG, TWENTY FIRST CHILD OF TOBIAS AND THE SIXTH CHILD OF TOBIAS AND MALISSA FISHER LONG, MARRIED CLEM KLINGLER, DECEMBER 25, 1897 AND LIVED ON A FARM THAT CLEM'S GRANDPARENTS, MICHAEL AND MAGDALENE FISHER OF PERRY COUNTY HAD ENTERED SEVERAL HUNDRED ACRES HERE IN HARDIN COUNTY IN 1837 AT \$1.25 AN ACRE UNDER PRESIDENT MARTIN VAN BUREN.

THE FISHERS GAVE PART OF THEIR PURCHASE, WHICH WAS THE PRESENT FARM WHERE EMMA AND CLEM LIVED, TO THEIR DAUGHTER HANNAH FISHER AND HUSBAND CHRISTOPHER KING WHO CAME TO HARDIN COUNTY IN 1840.

THE KINGS CLEARED WOODLANDS AND BUILT AND LIVED IN A LOG CABIN, THEY BUILT A DAM AND RAN A SAW MILL HERE. PART OF THE PRESENT HOUSE WAS BUILT AROUND 1850. CHRIS KING'S OLDEST DAUGHTER WAS LEAH AND WAS THE MOTHER OF CLEM KLINGLER. LEAH KING KLINGLER WAS 12 YEARS OLD WHEN HER FATHER CHRIS KING DIED BUT THE MOTHER REARED HER FAMILY ON THIS FARM. LEAH KING MARRIED ADAM KLINGLER IN FEB. 1871. IN 1901 EMMA AND CLEM BOUGHT THE CHRIS KING FARM AND RENTED IT SEVERAL YEARS AND THEN THEY MOVED THERE IN MARCH OF 1904 AND RAISED THEIR FAMILY. EIGHT CHILDREN WERE BORN WITH THREE OF THEM DYING BEFORE THE AGE OF 4. LEO THE OLDEST RAISED 9 CHILDREN WITH ALL LIVING AROUND THE WOOSTER AREA, BUT ONE WHO DIED A FEW YEARS AGO AFTER HIS MOTHER'S DEATH.

THERE ARE FOUR BOYS LIVING, THREE OF THEM ARE FARMERS LIVING WITH THEIR FAMILIES AROUND THE HOME COMMUNITY. ELZA HAS SPENT A GOOD SHARE OF HIS LIFE IN THE GROCERY AND MEAT BUSINESS. HE IS NOW LIVING IN MICHIGAN.

SOME OF THE YOUNGER KLINGLERS HAVE GOTTEN SOMEWHAT AWAY FROM FARMING. EDISON IS AN EXTENSION AGENT OF HARDIN COUNTY.

EMMA CELEBRATED HER 95TH BIRTHDAY ON FEB. 14TH AT THE RICHLAND MANOR NURSING HOME WHERE SHE HAS BEEN A RESIDENT FOR A FEW YEARS. SHE GOT A CARD FROM PRESIDENT NIXON. WHEN ASKED IF SHE WOULD CHANGE HER VOTE NOW, SHE REPLIED, "I VOTE FOR NOBODY".

THE SAME FARM THAT EMMA AND CLEM LIVED ON FOR SO MANY YEARS HAS RECENTLY BEEN BOUGHT BY ROBERT AND DIAMOND KLINGLER, YOUNGEST LIVING SON OF THE KLINGLERS.
